

**NEUROLOGY/CHILD NEUROLOGY PART II PATIENT AND VIGNETTE
SAMPLE SCORE CARDS
April 2008**

Neurology/Child Neurology: Each of the three sections of the examination (adult/child patient, adult vignettes, child vignettes) is scored separately. Scores of 1-4 are unacceptable, and scores of 5-8 are acceptable.

For the patient sections, 9 components are rated 1-8 by two examiners for a maximum score of 144 (9 components x 8 x 2 examiners). The pass/fail standard has been set at 82/144. The candidate must achieve a score of 82 or greater to pass the patient section of the Part II Neurology/Child Neurology Examination.

For the vignette sections, 6 vignettes are rated 1-8 by one examiner for a maximum score of 48 (6 vignettes x 8). The pass/fail standard has been set at 28/48. The candidate must achieve a score of 28 or greater to pass the vignette sections of the Part II Neurology/ Child Neurology Examination.
