

Psychiatry Part II Vignette and Patient Sample Score Cards

The maximum score for each vignette and patient examination is eight. Scores of one through four (1-4) are unacceptable, and scores of five through eight (5-8) are acceptable.

For the vignette section, each case is rated 1-8 by one examiner for a maximum score of 32 (four cases x 8).

For the patient section, each of two examiners rates the performance 1-8 for a maximum score of 16 (two examiners x 8).

The candidate's total score is the sum of the scores for the four vignettes plus the sum of the scores for the patient examination doubled (maximum total score = 64). The score for the patient section is doubled so that the patient score and the vignette score contribute equally to the final score. The candidate must achieve a score of 40 or greater to pass the Part II Psychiatry Examination.
