Making the Transition: From the 10-Year MOC Program to the Continuous MOC (C-MOC) Program

The C-MOC Program:

- Provides a more manageable requirement timeline.
- Offers a customized online ‘Activity Attestation’ section in ABPN Physician Folios to view and track your own MOC requirements.
- Easily tracks your MOC participation to maintain your Board Certification status.
- Provides a direct link to approved Self-Assessment (SA) and Improvement in Medical Practice (PIP) activity lists that will help you meet the ABPN Board activity requirements.
- Offers convenient online payment of board certification fees.
- Requires completion of just one set of activity requirements to satisfy all certifications.

	10-Year MOC Program	C-MOC Program
Who does this program apply to?	Applies to those who passed an exam prior to 2012 and who are taking a recertification exam between 2017 and 2021.	Applies to those who pass a certification or MOC exam in 2012 and later.
What is the exam requirement?	Take and pass recertification exam every 10 years.	Take and pass MOC exam every 10 years.
What are the fees?	One fee paid at time of applying for MOC exam.	Annual fee covers one MOC examination in a 10-year period.*
What are the MOC activity requirements?	300 Category 1 CME credits, including 24 Self-Assessment CME credits, and 1 PIP unit.	90 Category 1 CME credits, including 24 Self-Assessment CME credits, and 1 PIP unit. One time Patient Safety course required starting in 2016.
When are the MOC activity requirements due?	Prior to applying for the MOC exam.	Every three years (in 3-year blocks)
What do I need to attest to?	Attest to completing CME, Self-Assessment, and PIP when applying for MOC exam.	Attest to completing CME, Self-Assessment, and PIP every three years, and a one-time Patient Safety course, in Folios ‘Activity Attestation’ section.

*Factored into the MOC annual fee is the cost of maintaining and administering the ABPN Physician Folios system as well as the cost of MOC exam development.
