The Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Science Department at Northwestern University's Feinberg School of Medicine is conducting a survey-based study, approved by Northwestern University's Institutional Review Board, titled "Exploring professional practices between psychiatrists and psychologists and advantages and barriers to the use of psychological assessment."
