ABPN Decreases Fees for 2020 Initial Certification Exams

- The ABPN has decreased fees for the 2020 certification exams.
- Initial certification fees have dropped by 40 percent since 2007.
- These fees are 20 percent less than the average for all ABMS Member Boards.

ACGME Approves Subspecialty Training in Neurocritical Care

- The Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) approved the ABPN's proposal to accredit fellowship programs in the new subspecialty of Neurocritical Care at a February 2019 meeting.
- Eligible pathway criteria is now available on the [ABPN website](#).
- The first administration of the exam will be in 2021.
