Applications Now Available for ABPN 2021-22 Faculty Innovation in Education Awards and 2021-22 Research Awards

July 20, 2020, Deerfield, Ill. – Applications for both the 2021-22 Faculty Innovation in Education Awards and the 2021-22 Research Awards are now available from the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, Inc. (ABPN) on its website abpn.com.

The ABPN Directors recently reinstated the two award programs for 2021-2022. The awards were put on hold earlier in the year due to the disruption related to the COVID-19 epidemic.

The **ABPN Faculty Innovation in Education Award** supports the development of innovative education and/or evaluation projects that promote effective residency/fellowship training or lifelong learning of practicing psychiatrists and neurologists. The duration of the fellowship will normally be for two years with a maximum amount of funding of \$50,000 per year or \$100,000 total.

The 2021-22 application and accompanying materials are due to the ABPN by October 12, 2020. Recipients will be announced by December 1, 2020, with funding to start on January 1, 2021.

The **ABPN Research Award** supports research projects related to the mission of the ABPN, which is to promote and assess the competency of psychiatry and neurology candidates for initial and continuing certification (maintenance of certification). The maximum amount of funding available is \$100,000 per award and projects may take up to two years to complete.

The 2021-22 application and accompanying materials are due to the ABPN by October 19, 2020. Recipients will be announced by December 1, 2020, with funding to start on January 1, 2021.
