# ABPN Diplomates Now Pay a Discounted Rate for AAAP CME/Self-Assessment

American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology (ABPN) Diplomates who are not members of the American Academy of Addiction Psychiatry can now access any of AAAP's remote self-assessment and CME activities for the same cost as charged to AAAP members.

As a result of the pandemic, AAAP is holding its three major educational activities virtually in 2020, which include: the *Addictions and Their Treatment Course*, the *Advanced Addiction Psychopharmacology Course*, and the *31st Annual Meeting and Scientific Symposium*. ABPN provided a grant to AAAP to offset the cost of providing these courses, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

(10 Self-Assessment Category 1 CME Credits)  
December 10 through December 13
