Article Based Continuing Certification (ABCC) Pathway Update

In July, the ABPN announced the new [Article Based Continuing Certification \(ABCC\) Pathway](#) for continuing certification in 2022.

The ABCC Pathway is an ongoing professional journal article-based assessment activity designed as an optional alternative to the current traditional 10-year recertification/CC examination. The ABCC Pathway will be the default assessment option for current and new diplomates, unless the exam option is chosen.
